Dear Neighbor,

I am very excited to inform you that the Stewart Manor Pool will open for the season on Saturday, June 19th at 11am. I know from the many who continue to stop me and say "I can't wait until the pool opens" that the pool opening and the beginning of summer can't come soon enough. We are now entering the third year of our newly remodeled pool complex. Last year was a tremendous success. The feedback was great and the membership was strong and we are looking forward to another fun-filled summer in our brand new facility. We are very proud of the fact that even during this tough economic environment we have not increased our membership rates for the third consecutive year.

This year will bring even more changes at our pool. We have purchase a few new tables and chairs, we have also purchased two new vacuums. We previously only had one vacuum that died during the last week of last season. With the two new vacuums we will be able to keep the pools even cleaner than before and we plan NOT to close the Kiddie pool before the main pool, depending on the lighting. You may have also noticed that the pool and SMCC parking lot has been repaved. It was it need of repair and now looks great. The best part about these improvements, repairs and few additional items to come is that they were paid through a grant that the Village received for our pool complex

We are also going to continue the food service at the pool. The SMCC will once again provide food service. Last year this was so well received from our membership that we added Sunday after a few weeks. This year we are also adding Wednesday to the food service schedule. Our preliminary food service schedule is as follows: Wednesday through Friday 4pm to 8pm, Saturday 12 to 6pm and Sunday 12 to 5pm. There may be some delays during times when the SMCC has events taking place.

We are also looking to have a collection of Board games, coloring books, crayons, puzzles etc. available for borrowing (and are currently asking any residents who would like to make a donation of these items in very good condition to bring them to the Village Hall).

All of our previous year's activities will be continued such as family nights with entertainment, ice cream sundae nights, horse racing, arts and crafts and senior citizen teas etc.

Beginner swimming lessons and the swim team will again both be offered. We will begin charging a nominal cost for beginner swimming lessons of \$20 for your first child and \$10 for each additional child. There will be two sessions of two week lessons. The lessons will be on a first come, first served basis. A pre-season beginner swimmer registration is set for Friday June 11th at Village hall from 7 to 9pm. Please see more information on both the beginner swimming lessons and swim team inside. As in years past, all Stewart Manor residents may purchase a one-day family guest pass to the pool. The price of the pass will be \$35 and will allow up to 8 people to enter the pool for the day with a Stewart Manor resident (who does not need to be a pool member themselves). Please take advantage of the discount membership rate and have your application at Village Hall by Friday, June 4th

If you haven't been a previous pool member or not a recent member please consider joining your neighbors. Our pool complex is a wonderful place to spend some time with you family and neighbors during the summer months.

I am looking forward to another great pool season.

Swimming Lesson Information BEGINNER SWIMMER PROGRAM

The Stewart Manor Pool will be offering swimming lessons this year, although we are making several changes to the program. Our swimming lessons will now focus on young, beginner swimmers only. There will be a fee of \$20 for the first child on a membership and \$10 for each additional child on that membership. **There will be a special pre-season swimming lesson sign up on Friday, June 11 from 7pm to 9pm at the Village Hall.** The lessons will be on a first come, first served basis. There will be two sessions of two week lessons, with two beginner levels per session. The first session will begin on June 28 and run through July 9, Monday through Friday. The second session will begin on July 12 and run through July 23, Monday through Friday. The lessons will begin at 10 am and will last for 1/2 hour and will alternate between beginners and advanced beginners (for example, beginners at 10am, advanced beginners at 10:30am). The beginner lessons are for children between the ages of 5 and 7 as of June 19 and advanced beginners are for children older than age 7 through age 9 by June 19. No lessons will be offered to any child who has not reached their fifth birthday by June 19. There will be additional sign ups at the pool once it is open, only if there is space remaining. It is hoped that by refocusing our swimming lesson program, we can devote more time and attention to our youngest, most inexperienced swimmers. We suggest that any older child or more advanced swimmer join the swim team to perfect their strokes and gain additional practice.

Family Membership: Immediate members of the family residing at the same residence. Immediate members of the family are parents, partners or legal guardians, their pre-school children and their children who are unmarried, full-time students at accredited institutions up to age 23. Married or working sons and daughters, grandparents, or other relatives living at the same address must apply for separate membership.

Rate: \$ **530** Discounted rate (if application received by June 4, 2010): \$ **500**

Couple Membership: Any two immediate family members in same household.

Rate: \$ **505** Discounted rate (if application received by June 4, 2010): \$ **475**

Individual Membership: Any one person in a household. Each household may purchase only one individual membership. If there are multiple members of a household joining, please join as a couple or a family.

Rate: \$ **405** Discounted rate (if application received by June 4, 2010): \$ **375**

Senior Citizen Membership: An individual 65 years of age or older (by June 19th).

Rate: \$ **230** Discounted rate (if application received by June 4, 2010): \$ **200**

Nanny: An individual providing childcare to a pool member family during the months of June, July and August. Both pool member and nanny must sign a notarized statement which can be found at the Village Hall or on the Village web site: www.stewartmanor.us and must be submitted with this application.

POOL RULES 2010 Summer Season

- The Supervisor on duty shall be the absolute authority at the pool.
- Lifeguards are required to enforce and maintain all regulations for your protection. Please cooperate. Anyone not adhering to the rules may be asked to leave the pool facility and/or have their membership revoked.
- Children under the age of 11 MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult, age 18 or over. For the safety of all concerned, it is expected that the accompanying adult will remain in attendance and be responsible for the actions of the children concerned.
- Parents and legal guardians shall be responsible for the conduct and behavior of their children at all times in order that all regulations regarding safety and the use of the pool are fully complied with.
- No glass or sharp objects (including glass bottles) are permitted within the pool facility.
- Smoking is not permitted on the pool premises.
- Gum is not permitted on the pool premises.
- There are to be no baby carriages and strollers around the main pool or within the fence of the small pool whatsoever for safety reasons. Baby carriages and strollers must remain within the area west of the ramp that leads to the large pool and outside of the fence which surrounds the small pool. Strollers may be located within the fenced area by the snack bar, room permitting.
- Fire lanes must be kept free of strollers, baby carriages, bikes, tables and chairs at all times.
- Swim diapers must be worn by all diaper age children.
- Persons having skin lesions, inflamed eyes, mouth, nose or ear discharges, or having any type of bandage or adhesive tape on their body shall not be permitted to use the pool.
- Ball playing, running, pushing, throwing others into the pool, use of profane language or any other behavior causing annoyance is prohibited.
- The use of swimming or diving gadgets such as diving masks, snorkel tubes, flippers, water wings etc. are not permitted in the pool for safety reasons. Limited exceptions may be made in the small pool on a case by case basis.
- No street clothes are permitted in the pool.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on pool premises, except for special events where specifically permitted.
- The playing of music out loud is prohibited (except for events as directed by the pool supervisor). Only personal music players with earphones are permitted.
- Only one person at a time will be permitted on the diving board. Divers must swim to the nearest ladder upon surfacing and exit the water. Diving is at swimmer's own risk. No diving is permitted from the side of the pool at any time.
- Membership is non-transferable.
- All persons entering the pool MUST check in at the front gate. Passes are subject to revocation if presented by anyone other than the person to whom issued.
- Residents of Stewart Manor who do not join the pool are not permitted as guests of other members. However, any resident may purchase a one day pool pass at the Village Hall which will admit up to 8 people.
- All guests must wear the wristlets issued to them at the time of their registration and payment of a guest fee. The pool supervisor reserves the right to deny access to guests at their discretion.
- Membership may be revoked for failure to comply with all sanitary and safety rules, as well as regulations specified for administration of the pool facilities.
- The pool facility will not be rented out for private parties. Exceptions are for functions coordinated and run by the recreation and pool staff (adult pool party, fire department pool party etc.).

The foregoing rules are designed for your enjoyment and safety. They will be supplemented or amended as may be found necessary.
