

VILLAGE OF STEWART MANOR RULES OF CONDUCT FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS

The purpose of these rules is to maintain decorum and order for members of the public attending all Village of Stewart Manor public meetings.

1. Persons in the audience will refrain from behavior which will disrupt the public meeting. This will include making loud noises, shouting, or engaging in any other activity in a manner that disturbs, disrupts or impedes the orderly conduct of the meeting.
2. Persons in the audience will refrain from creating, provoking or participating in any type of disturbance involving physical contact.
3. Persons in the audience will refrain from using cellular phones while the meeting is in session.
4. If the Board so desires to conduct a public comment section, persons wishing to address the Board shall raise their hand and wait to be recognized by the Mayor/Chair.
5. If you are physically able, stand and address the Board from your seat.
6. Provide your name and address at the beginning of your remarks.
7. The time limit for remarks is at the discretion of the Mayor/Chair of the meeting and may be limited when appropriate.
8. Abusive language will not be tolerated. Comments are to be made to the Board, not other residents in attendance.
9. Speakers and any other members of the public will not approach the dais at any time without prior consent from the Mayor or Mayor/Chair.

Failure to comply with these rules of conduct may result in removal from the meeting and future meetings.
